- 8,000 greyhounds endure lives of terrible confinement at Florida tracks, kept for 20 to 23 hours each day in cages barely large enough for them to stand up or turn around.
- Since the state began tracking greyhound deaths in 2013, nearly 500 dogs have died at Florida tracks. On average, a greyhound dies at a Florida dog track every three days.
- Florida is one of only two states that does not publicly report greyhound injuries. A single county, Seminole, began tracking greyhound injuries in May 2017. Since then dozens of greyhound injuries have been reported.
